

FWCJUA ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

Board of Governors:

The operation of the FWCJUA is subject to the supervision of a 9-member Board of Governors. Eight board members are appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Financial Services Commission (the "FSC") and the ninth board member is the consumer advocate appointed under section 627.0613, Florida Statutes. The FSC selects two board members from among five nominees for each seat submitted by the 20 largest domestic writers of workers' compensation insurance in Florida; two board members from among five nominees for each seat submitted by the 20 largest foreign writers of workers' compensation insurance in Florida; one board member from among five nominees submitted by the largest property and casualty insurance agents' association in Florida; and three additional board members. The FSC also selects one of the nine board members to serve as the board chair. The current Board members are:
